CHS Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. How do I register my child for camp?

Please call 912.651.6823 x3 or email us at childrensevents@chsgeorgia.org to obtain the necessary registration forms and pay the deposit.

2. Will you hold a spot for my child while I'm researching other camps?

Unfortunately, due to the high volume of interest, we are unable to hold spots for campers without a deposit. Camp sessions fill up quickly, so be sure to make your decision as soon as you are able.

3. When is the balance due for camp?

New for 2011: Camp balance is due no later than the week prior to the first day of camp.

4. May I register my child or children for multiple weeks of camp?

Yes! If you register your child or children for multiple weeks of camp, you will receive a 10% discount off of your camp fees!

5. Must my child be fully potty-trained in order to attend camp?

Yes. We do understand/expect the occasional accident, but are unable to change diapers or disposable underwear throughout the day. Camp is an exciting, busy time at the Georgia State Railroad Museum, and we must give all attendees the same level of attention.

6. I'd like to enroll my 6-year-old in the 3-to-5-year-old camp session. Is this permitted?

Yes. If you feel that your child would be more comfortable with a different age level, you are welcome to enroll him or her in that camp.

7. What should my child bring/wear to camp?

Your child should wear comfortable clothing and closed-toe comfortable shoes. He or she should bring their lunch, unless you have requested lunch to be handled by us.

8. My child has food allergies. Will he or she be able to attend camp?

Absolutely! If you feel that you need to speak with someone about your child's allergies, we welcome you to do so.

9. Where should I drop off and pick up my child?

The Georgia State Railroad Museum is located off of Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. and Louisville Road, behind the Parker's gas station and Marriott Residence Inn. Our parking lot is accessible off of Louisville Road. Camp drop off and pick up is held right outside of our gift shop, which is the first brick building that you will see upon entering the parking lot.
